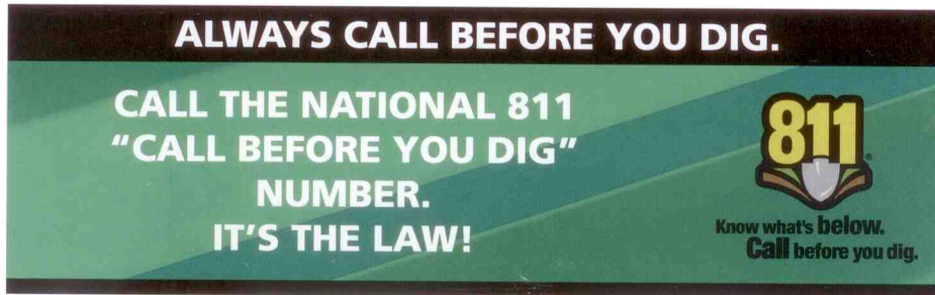


Call Before You Dig. It's the Law.

Planting a tree, building a fence, installing a swimming pool or any other work that requires digging? To help prevent accidents from occurring, the law requires you to contact the One-Call center at least 48 hours before you plan to dig.



Now there is a new national One-Call number that will help protect you from unintentionally hitting underground utility lines. It's easy to dial, simple to do, and best of all, it's free. 811 is the new number you should call before you begin any digging project.

When you call 811, we will be contacted by the One-Call center and we will send a representative to the site to mark the location of our pipeline on your property for free. Four simple steps can prevent most third-party pipeline accidents:

- **DIAL 811**
- **WAIT 48 hours for the site to be marked**
- **RESPECT the marks**
- **DIG with care**

In the event you hit our pipeline or see someone working on or near the ROW, call us immediately at (800) 720-2417. Even minor dents, chips or scrapes are serious and may cause future concerns if the problem is not professionally repaired.

Don't ever assume you know where the underground utilities are located. You can do your part to help ensure your safety and the safety of your community by protecting the pipeline against damage.
