

BELLVILLE GENERAL HOSPITAL

Bellville General Hospital, located four blocks from the downtown county courthouse, serves the residents of Bellville and Austin County as well as surrounding communities. BGH is the only hospital in Austin County, population 28,417, based on the most recent 2010 U. S. Census figures.

The hospital campus encompasses 4.197 acres of land. BGH is a licensed 32-bed acute care facility fully accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations. BGH is a member of the Texas Hospital Association, AMA and TORCH. It is certified by the U. S. Dept. of Health and Human Services (Medicare) and participates in the Medicaid program.

An adjoining medical professional building includes the offices of independent physicians, physical therapy and rehabilitation facilities as well as a local pharmacy. The BGH medical staff continues to grow with both active and consulting physicians seeing patients in Bellville. For over 83 years, BGH has been a viable part of this growing county. Bellville General Hospital is a not-for-profit healthcare provider with an active Auxiliary and Foundation that help to promote and support the hospital in various ways.
