## ORDER RESCINDING PROHIBITION OF OUTDOOR BURNING COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER OF AUGUST 19, 2019 AUSTIN COUNTY, TEXAS

- **WHEREAS**, in accordance with provisions of Chapter 418, Texas Government Code, a state of disaster was declared based on the imminent threat of disaster from wildfire; and
- WHEREAS, rainfall countywide and the current weather conditions indicate disaster conditions no longer exist;
- **BE IT ORDERED** that Commissioners Court Order Of August 19, 2019 prohibiting outdoor burning is hereby rescinded. Citizens are urged to exercise extreme caution when burning as follows:
  - 1. Observe wind speed and direction
  - 2. Choose safe burning site
  - 3. Have water source and hose at hand
  - 4. Do not leave fires unattended
  - 5. Be sure fires are completely extinguished
  - 6. Notify 979-865-3112 when starting any large fire
